### 4Days 3Nights Islamic Experience Brunei

#### Day 1 – Airport – Bandar Seri Begawan

Meet & greet at Brunei International Airport. Visit **Kampong Sungai Matan (optional)** for cottage industries visit. Transfer to Hotel. In the evening, perform Maghrib prayers at the iconic **Sultan Omar Ali Saifuddien Mosque** - the magnificent mosque sits at the heart of the capital city and the country's Islamic faith. Officially opened in 1958 and named after the 28th Sultan of Brunei. After prayers, enjoy a local dinner at your own expenses at Bandar (Town) while touring Bandar at night, with a stop at the **Gadong Mall** and the **Night Market**. Return to hotel for overnight.

#### Day 2 – Bandar Seri Begawan MIB Tour and Kampong Ayer Tour ( B,L )

After breakfast at hotel, visit to the Pusat Dakwah to meet new converts acquiring Islamic knowledge. Continue with a visit to '**Balai Pameran Islam Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah**' (**Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Islamic Exhibition Gallery**) at the **Mufti's Office**, to view some of His Majesty's prized collection of ancient Holy Qurans and manuscripts in various forms and sizes, written on various materials in various shapes, as well as to gain an insight into Brunei's unique Malay Islamic Monarchy philosophy. The Gallery also displays various **mushafs** originating from all over the world such as Middle East, North Africa, North and South Asia and the Archipelago and one of them is the oldest 1,000 years old mushaf from Maghribi written in kufi calligraphy. A visit to this gallery will not be completed without stopping at the Special Gallery where the Replica's of Islamic relics and artifacts from Topkapi Palace such as "**Pedang dan Tapak Rasulullah SAW**", "**Pedang Nabi Daud**", "**Tongkat Nabi Musa**" and "**Pedang Para Sahabat**" are on display.

Once the visit is completed, proceed for a photo stop by the **Istana Nurul Iman**, the world's largest residential palace, home of the Sultan of Brunei and seat of Government, then visit the magnificent **Jame'Asr Hassanil Bolkiah Mosque** and perform Zuhur prayers in Brunei's largest prayer hall, where Friday's khutbah is usually delivered to the nation. After prayers, stop at Beribi to savour lunch at Millennium Restaurant, after lunch, proceed to the banks of the Brunei River and embark on a local watercraft to visit the original Venice of the East, Brunei's famous **Kampong Ayer** – a township of multi-coloured houses built on stilts over Brunei River.

Drop by the **Kampong Ayer Cultural & Tourism Gallery** to learn about the settlement, watch a craft demonstration and pick up some souvenirs. Stroll around the wooden plank walks to see the daily life activities of the residents. Perform Asar prayers at one of the Kampong Ayer Mosque. Bank on land, transfer to hotel. Pick-up for Maghrib prayers at **Serusop Mohamed Bolkiah Mosque** and follow by a dinner at Aminah Ariff (at own expenses) to sample local delicacy - Ambuyat. Browse for textiles or imported good at the **Delima Shopping Complex**, Vast selections of unique fabrics of Baju Kurong for ladies or Baju Melayu for men. "Shop-till-you drop" before transfer back to hotel.

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**Day 3 – Bandar Seri Begawan Heritage ( B, L )**

After breakfast at hotel, visit the bustling riverside **Tamu Kianggeh** and discover an array of exotic foodstuffs and medicinal plants sold at Bandar's oldest market. Visit the **Malay Technology Museum** which offers an inside look into the intricacies of indigenous workmanship which is in danger of disappearing as the country adopts modern technologies. Then visit the **Brunei Museum** to see the exquisite illuminated copies of the Quran, and 1000 years old ceramics, jewellery, weapons and coins which is famed for its collection of priceless Islamic artifacts before stopping by the **Royal Mausoleum of Sultan Bolkiah**. Stop by the **Handicraft Center**, where Brunei's age-old traditional arts and crafts are showcased at this centre which aims to preserve their rich legacy. Taking pride of place are Brunei's famous brocades – 'kain tenunan' woven with gold and silver threads. Lunch at Tarindak Restaurant, proceed to perform Zuhur prayer at the iconic **Sultan Omar Ali Saifuddien Mosque**.

After prayer, continue shopping at the beautiful modern Malay architecture of the **Yayasan Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Shopping Complex** with possibility of shopping for souvenirs, textiles or imported goods at the shopping complex. The next stop is the spectacular **Royal Regalia** building. A tribute to the Sultan and the grand trappings of royalty, this museum is a highlight of any trip to Brunei. There is also the Constitutional History Gallery, which houses documents, photographs, film and recordings, and gallery devoted to the life of His Majesty The Sultan up to the time of his coronation. Stop by at the **Royal Mausoleum of Sultan Sir Haji Omar Ali Saifuddien III, Sultan Ahmad Tajuddin, Sultan Muhammad Jamalul Alam and Sultan Hashim Jalilul Alam Aqamaddin** before proceed to the **Empire Hotel & Country Club** to experience a truly regal welcome. This palatial property featuring, marble-clad walls, gold embellishment and Muranao crystal is a perfect for luxurious sojourn. Indulge yourself to an elegant English Hi-Tea (own expenses) served on 3 tier-stacked Asprey Silver. Return to hotel for overnight.

**Day 4 – Bandar Seri Begawan ( B )**

After breakfast free at own leisure until check-out, pick-up and transfer to another textiles mall before proceed to airport for return flights in the evening.
